HOMECOMING FAQS

- Do I need to be financial to participate? Yes, you must be financial and registered for homecoming through the M100ABA.
- What does registration mean? You will receive your credentials, which are a homecoming memento, a tailgate ticket, and a homecoming t-shirt. Please note that the game ticket is only included in the following packages: Financial Packages Options 3 & 4; Nonfinancial Packages Options 3 & 4.
- What do I wear to participate? You must have on the official M100ABA warm-up suit (black/white) with the 2022 Homecoming T-shirt.
- How will I receive my homecoming package? You must be present and pick up your homecoming package at Recital Hall on Friday, October 28th, between 4:00 PM and 6:30 PM or during the tailgate, Saturday, October 29th, at 12 noon. We will not distribute your purchase to anyone else.
- Can I purchase a homecoming package at this time? No, only game tickets & a few tailgate tickets are available until we are sold out.
- Can I purchase Florida Classic Tickets? Florida Classic tickets are SOLD OUT. Further informtion regarding the Florida Classic will be sent out after homecoming.
- What time is the lineup and warm-up for the parade? Please report to the corner of Wahnish Way and Orange Ave (Bethel AME/FAMU DRS) by 7:00 AM. The parade starts at 8:00 AM.
- What is the parade sequence? Backstabbers, SOS, Just Got Paid & Oh Happy Day.
- Do I need a ticket to get a meal at the tailgate? Yes. All alumni band members that purchased a homecoming registration have a tailgate ticket. If any member purchased any additional tailgate tickets, he/she will receive the additional tailgate tickets purchased at the time of pickup.

HOMECOMING FAQS (CONTINUED)

- Will merchandise be sold at the tailgate? Yes, there will be a pop-up store during the tailgate. Please make sure you have a cell phone that can accept a QR code for Zelle or regular credit card payment. No cash will be accepted.
- What time is the alumni photo? The official photo will take place on the steps of the Foster Tanner building at 3:00 PM.
- Do I need a game ticket? Yes, everybody needs a game ticket to enter Bragg Stadium.
- Was a complimentary Homecoming game ticket included in my early bird dues? No.
- Was a complimentary Homecoming game ticket included in my \$36.40 Homecoming registration cost? No.
- What if I am a season ticket holder or I purchase from somewhere else, can I still sit with the Alumni band? Seats will be guaranteed only to individuals who purchased through the M100ABA. We will make room for others once our M100ABA ticket holders have been guaranteed a seat.
- How will the seats be organized? The seats will be divided into two sections within Section J.
 Rows 35 46 will be for the playing alumni and Rows 29-34 will be for the spectators.
- Does my child need a ticket? According to the Athletics website, all persons entering Bragg Stadium must present a valid game ticket for entry.
- "Are bags allowed into Bragg Stadium? Only small clear bags are allowed, no larger than 12x6x12.
- Will I be able to sit with the Marching 100 Band during the 4th Quarter? Only alumni band members that are registered for homecoming <u>AND</u> in full alumni band uniform(black warmup & 2022 Homecoming T-Shirt) can sit with the band. Per Dr. Chipman, no one is allowed to stand in front of, nor alongside the band.

You will receive your homecoming game tickets through the email address you registered with. The email will be from the FAMU Box Office. (Please check spam folder.)
